








iPads in the Math Classroom

1. Use Algebra Touch  to practice simple algebra strategies such as order of operations, addition and multiplication.
2. Have students use the educreations  or show me  app to work out math problem in class.
3. Try a math website like Brain Genie or AAA math for great math practice.
4. Use Wolfram Alpha  to have the student's search by their birth date, enter a calculation, city, measurement.
5. Use Free Books  to have students search for math books to download and read. Have them pick out a math fact or problem from the story to share with the class.
6. Post a word problem to Edmodo  and ask students to reply with an answer.
7. Have student find a Kahn Academy  video matching the standards you are teaching that week.
