









## iPads in the Science Classroom

1. Use 3D Brain  to explore the brain on the iPad. Have students discover its parts and functions.
2. Explore the night sky with Star Walk  to learn more about the stars, constellations and planets.
3. Students will have fun learning the periodic table with The Elementals  or for a more comprehensive look at the elements just tap the NOVA app .
4. Have students explore the NASA app  and then use the app. Have them take pictures of the app pressing the home button and sleep/wake button at the same time. Upload pictures to the educreations  or show me  app to illustrate what they've learned.
5. Use Science 360  to search for a current news article. Have students add the link to their Edmodo library or post to the group page.
6. Use Google Earth to explore earth landforms and bodies of water. Ask students to point out where they live.
